William 'Moose' Harrell was born in Fairfield, Alabama, home of rusting steel mills and working class folks. Despite growing up in a house filled with jazz and show tunes, the Americana chord ran deep. After a chance meeting with brother Troubadour Rick Carter in 1974 at a picnic table at the University of South Alabama, a decades-long partnership would follow, first with the band Highway, then with the perennial fan favorite Telluride.

After moving to Nashville in the late 80's, Moose followed his heart with stints in several roots acts such as the Thieves, the American Steel Band, Kevin Montgomery, Jeff Finlin, and Jason Ringenberg. Some career highlights include performing in bands with some of the all-time keyboard greats, including Larry Knechtel, Matt Rollings, and Nicky Hopkins, and with blues legend Johnny Shines.

As the dream continues, Moose is proud to bring lap steel, guitars and vocals to the Alabama Troubadours!
