Stan Foster grew up in Camden Arkansas, where he sang in church and school choirs. His biggest musical influence was The Beatles, which led him to study voice at Southern Arkansas University. Stan later moved to Birmingham, Alabama where he honed his skills through local gigs, while working days at a large music store.

Tapped for a touring job as bassist/ vocalist for Rollin' in the Hay in 1994, Foster has continued playing full time ever since. Stan performed on the Southern Rock Cruise and Rock Legends Cruise, and has shared the stage with Artemis Pyle Band, The Marshall Tucker Band, Jimmy Hall, The Kentucky Headhunters, and many others.

Stan moved to Mobile, Alabama in 2006, with his wife, Donna Hall, of Wet Willie fame. There he performs in several groups, including the wildly popular duo of Phil & Foster, when not touring with Rollin' in the Hay and The Alabama Troubadours.

He has been voted "Best Local Bassist" by the Mobile public from 2018-2021.
